Leaves are Falling! Unblock Those Storm Drains

If there is a storm drain along the edge of your property, help prevent street flooding and keep our water system free of debris as possible by clearing the drain of leaves. Even partially blocked drains can cause problems with fall rains and lead to ice jams in winter.

Help Keep Edgewater Walkable All Year— Keep Sidewalks Clear!

One of the best things about Edgewater is how walkable it is, for adults, children, and dogs alike! As you complete your fall cleanup, take time to trim bushes and trees that may overhang or block sidewalks, and rake leaves and debris off sidewalks.

When the snow starts to fly, please keep sidewalks as clear of snow and ice as possible. If you live on a corner, do your best to keep the path from the sidewalk to the street clear; this is not always an easy task but your efforts ensure pedestrians and pups have safe passage year round. City of Rockford Construction Updates

North Main Street: Currently, workers are finishing the new water main installation from Yonge to Willoughby. Utility relocations are still ongoing, and some will continue throughout the winter as weather permits. The pavement & intersection widening to accomplish staged construction should be completed before the end of 2016 construction. In 2017, full reconstruction between Yonge & the railroad crossing (around County Club Beach) will begin and last for the entire season.

Spring Creek Bike Path Study: The City has received the full corridor topography survey documents. Over the coming weeks they will be analyzing the information to ascertain the challenges with path alignments. It is clear from the initial study that there are some major right of way, grading, & utility issues that will need to be addressed, and at this point more study is needed to give a solid answer on feasibility. One option that is being considered is a phased approach to constructing the path.



Winter Parking & Snow Clearing Reminders

Odd/Even parking is always in effect always during a declared Snow Emergency to assist with snow clearing operations. Vehicles must be parked on the side of the street with odd-numbered addresses on odd-numbered days and on the side with even-numbered addresses on even-numbered days by 8:00am (for example, on Nov. 9 you'd park on the odd side of the street by 8:00am).

If your street is marked as "No Parking" on one side, a Snow Emergency declaration allows you to park legally in the restricted area during the time the Snow Emergency is in effect. Do not assume that you can move your car when the street is plowed, it must remain parked appropriately until after the Snow Emergency has been lifted. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated as it ensures Edgewater streets are thoroughly cleared after every storm. Call the City's Snow Hotline at 815.987.5771 with any questions.

Edgewater contracts with a private company to have all the alleys in the neighborhood plowed. The contractor is contacted to start plowing the alleys after 2 inches of snow have fallen. The money to pay this contractor comes from Edgewater membership dues as well as additional donations to the snow plow fund—use the form on the outside of this newsletter or visit www.rockfordedgewater.org to become a member!
