LUMINARIA CANDLE & BAG SALE AT VILLAGE GREEN SATURDAY - DECEMBER 1ST / 9AM - 4 PM



At dusk one December evening, our neighborhood comes together to illuminate our streets and yards with simple candlelit bags that create a beautiful sight. People from the entire Rockford area come to experience our luminaria night—the beauty and calmness are a magical part of the holiday season.

Once again, volunteers will set up and light 200 common area luminarias that will line the Auburn Street Bridge and Harlem Boulevard along the river.

The luminarias have the most impact when they're continuous strands of light, created by more participating households. So talk to your neighbors—make sure they're joining you in the fun! If you'd like to participate but aren't physically able, Boy Scout Troop 41 from Westminster Presbyterian Church on Bell School Road has offered to help you! Purchase your luminarias and contact troop leader Mike Lunde at 815.985.9522 by Dec. 1st if you'd like to schedule the Scouts to help set up the luminarias for your yard.

Bags and candles will be available at Village Green, 2640 North Main Street. (FREE sand for weighting bags is provided courtesy of William Charles; bring your own container to carry it home) Come meet us there and keep our Association strong and alleys clear by paying your 2013 membership dues and snow plow donations at the same time, by cash or check.

This year's candles have been upgraded to a larger diameter version, in response to concerns raised last year. Wondering how many luminarias you need for your yard? Resident expert Jeff Orput (who has kindly volunteered to head up this great effort again this year) says he places his about five feet apart.

Contact Jeff at 815.494.5443 to volunteer for an hour at Village Green or to help with luminaria set-up and lighting of the common areas. You'll get to meet your neighbors and make your holiday even more fun!



The City of Rockford plows our streets. However, homeowners are responsible for plowing our numerous alleys. Edgewater has hired the same snow contractor as last year to maintain continuity.

The contractor will make two passes down each alley, pushing snow to either side. Each resident is responsible for removing snow from the end of your apron/drive.
